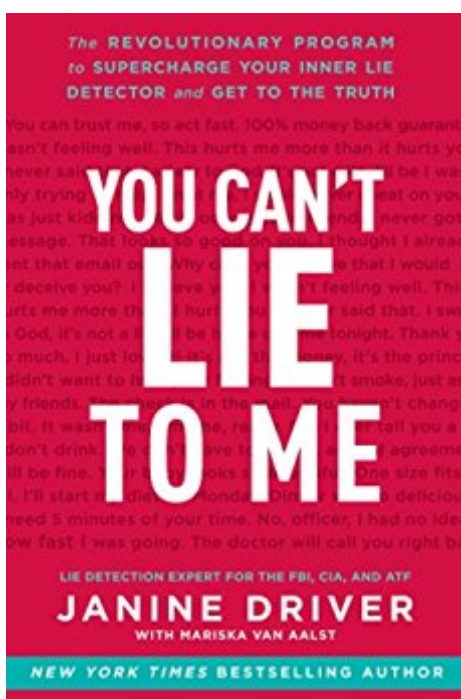

I lost count how many times Janine Driver refers the reader back to her first book giving the impression it was good and this follow up was to capitalize on it. I didn't find any new information, it was difficult to follow because she writes like she talks, as if you already know what the information is. There are many other books available that can teach you how to detect a liar or to watch for certain body language..choose any one of them and you'll be way ahead of anything gleamed from this book. I really wanted to like it because Driver can be an entertaining panel guest on cable TV but I just couldn't.

Although some of the author's observations about body language and behavior as an indicator that someone is lying to you is good information at times, I came away from reading this book that it is such a cynical view of the world. I'm not gullible but according to the author, it seems that anyone

who does an act of human kindness towards one another is suspect for having a malicious ulterior motive. It's a horrible way to go through life. I'd like to think that someone who does me a favor is doing it for the right reasons. I have bestowed random acts of kindness on strangers at times for no other reason than to have good karma in life and make someone's day. According to the author, she would think that I was being manipulative. It's just a depressing way to view the world.

This book had interesting information in it, but I think this author is not the best at writing. I read the entire book, but my interest was lagging behind before I got to the third chapter. I probably would not buy books from this author again.

Authors must get really upset when they see something like this. This book not only has a lack of structure and good writing, as many pointed out, but seems to have no research whatsoever. This happens, for instance, when the author uses Madoff as an example (I think - maybe it's just random comments that weren't attempting to get anywhere). Anybody who did cursory research on Madoff knew that he wouldn't meet most of his investors (they would invest through funds of funds. That's a small example, but the book reads like the author sat down and started writing - no going back, no improving of the chapters, no research, just grabbing some cash quickly

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
