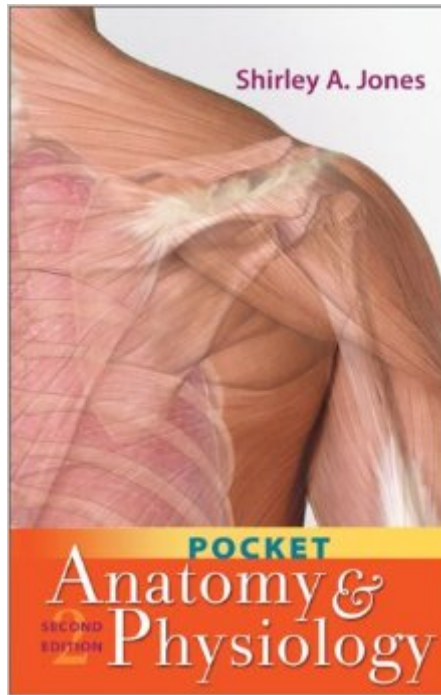


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Pocket Anatomy And Physiology

This is a very well thought out reference aid. First the size makes this invaluable to anyone studying anatomy. It's inconvenient to lug around those heavy heavy texts, and this way you can study and memorize the diagrams wherever you are. Anatomy takes a lot of time in memory and repetition in looking at diagrams. It's printed on waxy sturdy paper so it will take a beating. It's well organized & color coded into systems, much the way your textbook probably is. And the diagrams are beautifully illustrated- they tend to match the quality found in standard anatomy texts (I used Martini's text). the print can get small, especially in the crowded muscles section, but it's clearly labelled.
